

What is the building layout and where are the fire exits?



The AISAT building has a left and right wing layout. The emergency exit locations are indicated above.



How do I know my assigned classroom and schedule?

Classrooms will be assigned per section and will be posted at <u>https://aisat.edu.ph/subject-scheduling/</u> during the start of the semester. It will be also posted in the second floor lobby area in the registrar's bulletin board.

The assigned year level, section, and class schedule will also be posted at the door of the classroom it is associated with.

Where do I get my Certificate of Registration?

After completing the enrollment process, the registrar's office will email you a copy of your COR (Certificate of Registration) via your personal email (for **NEW** students) and AISAT assigned email (for **OLD** students). Please make sure you have your own copy to serve as proof that you are enrolled in that subject and schedule.

What should I know about examinations?

Examination schedules will be emailed to all students a week before the examination week. It will also be posted in your virtual Google Classrooms. The registrar's office will also be posting it in their bulletin board. This consists of the time for each subject and room assignment per section.

Exams will be conducted on site, at the set schedules, and each for a duration of 2 hours, unless a longer period is required by the instructor. Please inform your instructors at least 7 days in advance for exam conflict of schedule or at least 24 hours in advance (except extreme emergencies) in case of emergencies.

Only students wearing the appropriate uniform based on the day of the schedule will be allowed to take the examination.

When is my instructor available for consultation?

All regular instructors are available for consultation during scheduled class hours or online on weekdays from 1pm to 5pm. Part time instructors have their weekly consultation times scheduled. Students may directly chat with the faculty in the classroom, google chat or by email. Outside consultation time, instructors will reply to communications within office hours. If instructors are unresponsive, students may request for assistance from the program head or from the OSA.

Is there an evaluation process for my instructors?

Yes, an evaluation form from the OSA will be made available after midterms for you to fill out. These will be used as a basis for feedback to your instructors after each semester. Late registration is from **July 22, 2024** to **August 2, 2024**. Late fee of **P500** will apply.

NOTE: Students with lacking requirements will be notified and all required credentials should already be submitted by **August 5-9, 2024.**

When is adding and dropping?

Adding and dropping may be done only from **August 5-9, 2024**. This must be done in person at the Registrar's office.
